



The CLASS Center - Center for Foreign Languages - of the University for Foreigners of Siena delivers the foreign language courses offered by the University and promotes study and research activities. It is also possible to attend and take exams in single courses

Language courses can issue certificates through current accreditation systems, such as ECTS for European Institutions.

The languages activated for A.Y. 2022/2023 are: ARABIC, CATALAN, CHINESE, KOREAN, FRENCH, JAPANESE, ENGLISH, PORTUGUESE, RUSSIAN, SPANISH and GERMAN.

IMT School users are granted the following **discounted rates**:

• 126-hour (9 CFU) Language and Translation/Foreign Literature courses:

€ 200 + € 16 virtual revenue stamp. Courses are held in-person but upon specific request can be attended in blended mode on Google Meets. For English and Spanish languages, courses can also be offered in full online mode.

• Preparation courses for foreign language certification exams, 20 hours:

€ 120 + € 16 virtual revenue stamp in both blended and online mode.



Italian language courses:

(a) CLID (blended mode) courses, bimonthly of 80 hours.

**€ 280 + € 16 virtual revenue stamp** (instead of € 370 + the virtual revenue stamp).

These are 60 hours via Zoom and 20 hours on Moodle, organized 3 times a week for two months. Courses are active for all levels and scheduled in January/February, March/April, May/June, July/August, September/October, November/December.

(b) Intensive in-person courses (in Siena) of 80 hours (courses every month for all levels).

€ 404 + € 16 virtual revenue stamp (instead of € 570 + € 16 virtual revenue stamp).

Both CLID and intensive in-person Italian language courses provide credits and a final exam, with 75% Attendance. For those accessing the in-person Italian language courses and also intending to take the CILS Certification exam at the Siena facility, it is possible to take advantage of a discounted rate as already provided for students of UNISTRASI's in-house Italian language courses.
